

CNBOP-PIB manages its finances based on the principles appropriate for research institutes.

The activities of the Institute are financially supported in accordance with the Act of 30 April 2010 on the principles of financing science (Journal of Law 2010 no. 96 item 615 as amended). The Institute, in terms of certification and admittance activities, does not benefit from public aid or any other means.

Fees related to certification paid by the clients are determined taking into account the principles set out in the Regulation of the Minister of Finance of 14 June 2012 on the method of determining fees for activities relating to conformity assessment and accreditation of conformity assessment bodies (Journal of Law 2012 item 711).

Fees related to the processes of issuing, changing and admittance control of products paid by the clients are determined taking into account the principles set out in the Regulation of the Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration of 20 June 2007 on specific actions performed in the process of admittance, change and admittance control of products, fees charged by the authorized body and the method of setting fees for these activities (Journal of Laws 2007 no. 143 item 1001).
